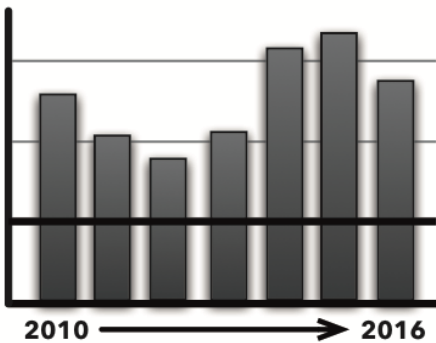

UNDER THE CONSERVATIVES, IMMIGRATION HAS GONE UP

In 2010, with Theresa May as Home Secretary, the Conservatives said that they would reduce immigration to 100,000 per year. On this chart, 100,000 is shown as a dark black line. Total net migration to the UK in the year ending September 2016 was 273,000.

FACT

A&E UNITS ARE BEING CLOSED & GPs ARE LEAVING THE NHS

One in seven Accident and Emergency units at hospitals across the country are at risk of closure or downgrading. The NHS are predicted to be **£22 BILLION over budget** by 2020. Meanwhile, GP surgeries are being closed and more than **a quarter of GPs plan to quit**.
